EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER

For emergencies 24 hours a day, call Shawn Lapeyrouse at 985-790-0505. For less urgent matters, call the office at 985-466-1401. Families may leave messages by calling 985-466-1401.

FIRST AID

For all medical needs, please go to the First Aid Station located, in the Meeting Room Wing, which is open during Conference Site hours. Youth requiring first aid must be accompanied by an adult. Medication requiring refrigeration should be checked in with the nursing staff.

LOST AND FOUND

This is located Central Office. If you realize after the conference that you lost something, call Lift 3:16, Inc. within two weeks to claim your items.

MARKETPLACE/CONCESSIONS

The Bookstore is located the Marketplace. The sale and distribution of any items is strictly prohibited without the permission of the Conference Director. Concessions will be sold in the lobby.

CHAPEL/PRAYER

The Chapel, Bayou Blessings, is open when the Conference Site is open. Prayer ministers are available for assistance during the conference. They are wearing red vests.

SMOKING

Except for designated outside areas, all conference venues are smoke-free facilities. During the sessions we ask all participants, including adult chaperones, to refrain from smoking.

DRESS CODE

All participants, including adults, are expected to dress appropriately in modest attire. Low-cut tops, mini skirts, short shorts, leggings without appropriate-length tops, or clothing with offensive language or obscene pictures are not allowed.

HEALTH

It is absolutely vital that you drink lots of water throughout the weekend. Water coolers are located just outside of the lobby doors.

ENTRANCE

Wristbands **MUST** be worn at all times. If you lose a wristband, immediately report to Central Office (youth must be accompanied by an adult chaperone). Lanyards do not suffice as "entry" for participants and wristbands **MUST** be worn to verify you are a participant.
